

Located next to the Parque de María Luisa in the Plaza de España, the Seville Military History Museum belongs to the Kingdom of Spain's Ministry of Defence Museum Network. Its objectives are to conserve, acquire, exhibit and carry out research into items of unquestionable historic, scientific, technical and artistic interest associated with the Spanish Army and with all types of military activity, and thereby to provide the new generations, and the civilian world in general, with a stimulating museum experience. The Museum opened in 1992 and was completely remodelled in 2000 to display the building's structure as originally conceived by Anibal González, the architect of the Plaza de España.0) Its three floors have a total exhibition space of 2,000 m2, in which there are more than 3,500 items on display. Between 2021 and 2022 the Museum was extensively refurbished and it now boasts the very latest museum technology, enlarged exhibition rooms and spaces specially adapted to accommodate temporary exhibitions. The Seville Military History Museum offers the people of Seville and all the city's visitors a magnificent opportunity to learn more about the history of the Spanish Army from its earliest moments of glory, free of charge and in the beautiful setting of the Parque Maria Luisa and the Plaza de España.








PLAN AND ELEVATION VIEWS OF THE MUSEUM'S THREE

VEXILLOLOGY ROOM

(Vexillology: the study of flags)

Exhibition of flags, standards, banners and pennants.

MAIN FLOOR

HISTORY ROOM

Spanish military history, the conquest of Seville, the War of Independence (Peninsular War), 20th century wars and battles. Historical uniforms and headwear, helmets, masks, plumes, caps, busbies, headdresses, kepis and berets.



CAPTAINCY ROOM

Armament and equipment from the Seville Artillery Works.

CHIEF OF STAFF ROOM

Armament and equipment from the Army's different specialist units.

ARMIES AND RETINUES ROOM

Ammunition and explosives, workshops.

PALADIN ROOM

Contemporary Army.

GUARDHOUSE ROOM

Compulsory Military Service, Lookout post.

QUARTERMASTER ROOM

Temporary exhibitions. Exhibition of miniatures.
