Ancona

is the main city in the Marche region in central Italy, a seaport on the Adriatic Sea.

It was founded by Greek settlers from Syracuse in about 387 BC, who gave it its name: Ancona stems from the Greek word Äykúv (Ankòn), meaning "elbow"; the harbour to the east of the town was originally protected only by the promontory on the north, shaped like an elbow.

The Greek origin of Ancona is remembered by the appellation "Doric city".

Main sights : Ancona Cathedral, Arch of Traian, The <u>National Archaeological Museum of the</u> <u>Marche Region</u> is housed in the Palazzo Ferretti.

Augusta

is one of the oldest Greek colonies of Sicily is situated in the province of Syracuse and faces the Ionian Sea. The old town is an island, made in the 16th century by cutting an isthmus and is connected to the mainland by two bridges. One bridge was built recently (Viaduct Frederick II of Swabia) and the other built when the city was founded and is called the Spanish Gate. Augusta is home to two ports.

Main sights: Museo della Piazzaforte, Palazzo Comunale, Piazza Duomo, Villa Comunale, Faro Santa Croce.

Cagliari

"Stone, naked and uphill," like a white Jerusalem, "so in 1921 British writer David Herbert Lawrence described Cagliari, "almost fantastic city" enclosed in the blue of the sea and white limestone rocks. Founded by the Phoenicians, colonized by the Carthaginians, occupied by the Romans, contended by Pisani and Spaniards, governed for a long time by the Piedmontese, the Sardinian capital keeps in the palaces, churches, works of art and language the sign of his long and moving history. At the top of the Castle Hill, it is the fortified citadel with its white walls and tall medieval towers dominating the city skyline.

La Maddalena is a town located on the island with the same name, in the province of Sassari, northern Sardinia, Italy. It is the largest town in the Maddalena archipelago (a protected marine and terrestrial area of national and Community interest), just 2 kilometres (1 mile) from the northeastern shore of Sardinia and sitting in the Straits of Bonifacio, between Sardinia and Corsica. The island has several beaches, including Bassa Trinita and Spalmatore. It is characterized by rocky granitic terrain and has some ancient fortifications. It is connected by causeway with the nearby island of Caprera, known as the residence of the Italian revolutionary Giuseppe Garibaldi.

La Spezia

at the head of the Gulf of La Spezia in the southern part of the Liguria region of Northern Italy. It is the second city in the Liguria region, just after Genoa. A significant railway junction, it is notable for its museums, for the Palio del Golfo rowing race, and for railway and boat links with the Cinque Terre.

Napoli

is the main city of Campania and the third-largest municipality in Italy after Rome and Milan. The city was an important part of Magna Graecia, played a major role in the merging of Greek and Roman society and a significant cultural centre under the Romans. It served as the capital of the Duchy of Naples, then of the Kingdom of Naples and finally of the Two Sicilies until the unification of Italy in 1861. Naples' historic city centre is the largest in Europe and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, with a wide range of culturally and historically significant sites nearby, including the Palace of Caserta and the Roman ruins of Pompeii and Herculaneum. Naples is also known for its natural beauties such as Posillipo, Phlegraean Fields, Nisida, and Vesuvius. Neapolitan cuisine is synonymous with pizza – which originated in the city – but it also includes many lesser-known dishes; Naples has the greatest number of accredited stars from the Michelin Guide of any Italian city.

Roma is the capital of the Italian Republic, with the largest historical center in the world.

During its three millennia of history, it was the first great metropolis of humanity, country of the most important ancient civilizations, which influenced society, culture, language, literature, art, architecture, philosophy, religion, law and customs for the following centuries. The place of origin of the Latin language was the capital of the Roman Empire, site of the Pontifical State under the temporal power of the popes, and capital of the Kingdom of Italy (from 1871 to 1946). It is defined as, the Urbe, Caput Mundi and the Eternal City. Its historic center, bordered by the perimeter of the Aurelian Walls, contains three millennia of the historic, artistic and cultural heritage of Western Europe. Rome, hosts The Vatican City (the smallest state in the world) is an independent country inside the city boundaries of Rome, the only existing example of a country within a city: for this reason Rome has been often defined as capital of two states.

Taranto

Ancient Greek colony estabilished by the Spartans, is known as the "Town of the Two Seas" for its geographical position on the horseback of Mar (Sea) Grande and Mar Piccolo, and the "Land of the Dolphins" for the historic establishment of a group of cetaceans beyond the islets of St. Peter and St. Paul, collectively called as Cheradi Islands. The Greek colonists called the city Taras while the Romans, who connected the city to Rome with an extension of the Appian way, called it Tarentum.

There is the National Archaeological Museum of Taranto (MARTA) which is an important museum center, where <u>one of the largest collections of artifacts of the time of Magna Grecia</u> <u>is exhibited</u>, including the famous Ori of Taranto (Taranto's Golds).
